Dear Parents and Seniors:

Seniors have two options for their senior yearbook picture. School pictures will be taken on October 6, 2011. This is the only time students may receive a student ID card. If seniors would like to use a private photographer their senior photos must be turned in to the yearbook office by 6:00 p.m. on Monday, October 3, 2011. If senior photos are not received by this deadline, the school picture taken by the school photographer will be used by the *Echo Log* staff. Classes will not be excused to have pictures taken by private photographers.

If using a private photographer your senior portrait can be turned in to the yearbook office physically, on a CD, or e-mailed (see address below).

When you have your photos taken, remember there are some requirements for the yearbook picture.

Required Photo Specifications

- All photos must be portrait (vertical) format, not landscape.
- All photos must feature students in compliance with the UCA dress code (**no jewelry, low-cut shirts, ripped jeans**).
- All physical photos MUST be actual prints and not printed on a standard printer

Minimum Requirements for Digital Photographs

- All digital photos must:
 - be a minimum of 300 dpi (dots per inch)
 - be taken with a camera with at least a 5 mega pixel definition quality (RAW)
 - be submitted EXACTLY as you wish it to appear in the *Echo Log*
 - be in standard file format (tiff preferred)
