It is with great pleasure that I write you from our beautiful campus awash in fall colors. With the crisp weather comes heightened student energy, lots of music, creative teaching, and sacks and sacks of potatoes! Blessings and good news should be shared, so I thought you would enjoy hearing about a few of the great things the Lord has blessed at Upper Columbia Academy.

Last summer some hard-working volunteers planted 800 pounds of seed potatoes in a one acre plot between the old cafeteria and the railroad tracks. We hoped for a crop of 5,000 pounds so we could feed the campus for the school year. Instead, our big God blessed us with almost 15,000 pounds, plus 3,000 pounds of carrots, 100 pounds of garlic and I lost count on the beets! UCA students have the home-grown, farm-to-table experience—a program we hope to expand.

I am especially thankful for our 237 students. We wouldn't exist without them! AND, I am indebted to our donors whose unselfish kindness makes worthy student scholarships possible for 80% of the students who couldn't come otherwise.

And finally, I'm thankful for the miracle I witnessed at our 70th Anniversary/Alumni Homecoming Weekend on October 3. When the programs were printed on Thursday afternoon before the events began Friday, we still owed \$56,588 to the conference on the mortgage for the Wallace Dining Commons, which we hoped to dedicate Sabbath afternoon. However, a debt-free status is required for a dedication. When the offering was counted after church, we had the entire \$56,588 AND \$120 left over! It was WONDERFUL to watch that mortgage burn! I praise God for all of you who contributed the funds for bricks and mortar, volunteered your expertise, or served as prayer support in this very recently-completed capital campaign.

As we approach the Christmas holidays, now not so far away, our thoughts turn to all that goes into preparing for them. I remember as a kid sitting with the Sears Catalogue dreaming about all the "what if's" and marking page after page of "I want this, and this and this" As an adult, I find myself much more excited about giving than getting.
