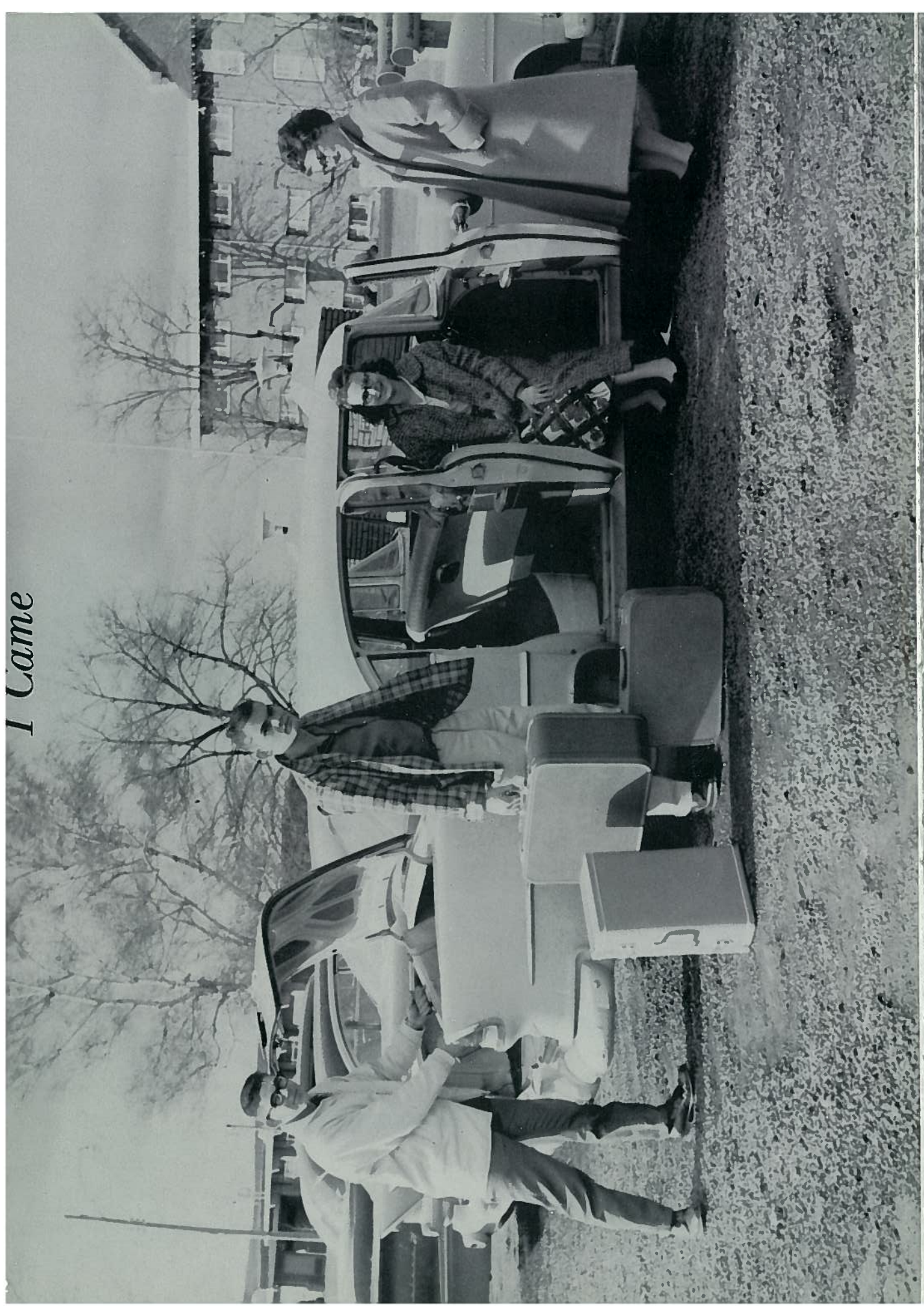

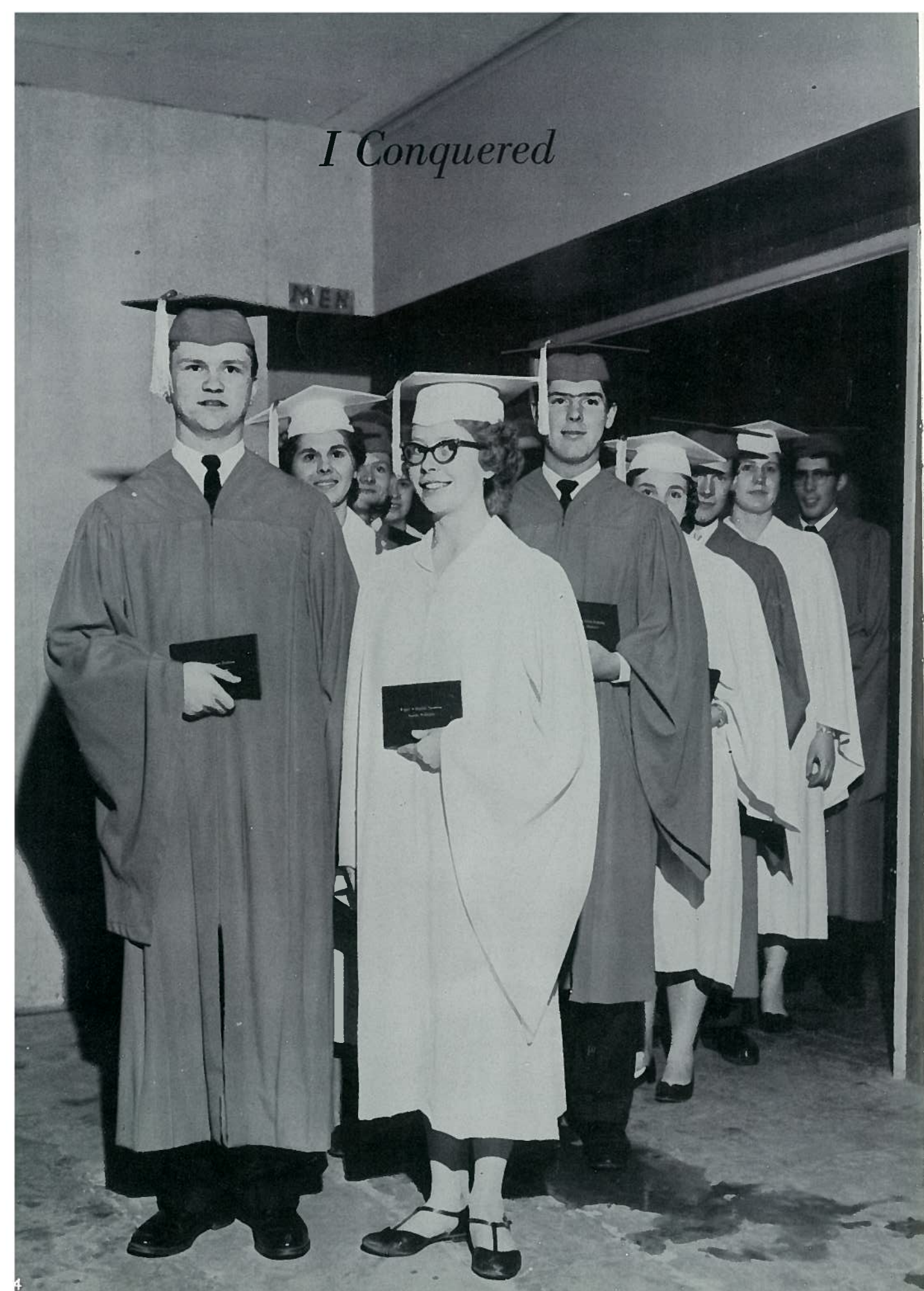

Are blessings just sent in disguise."*

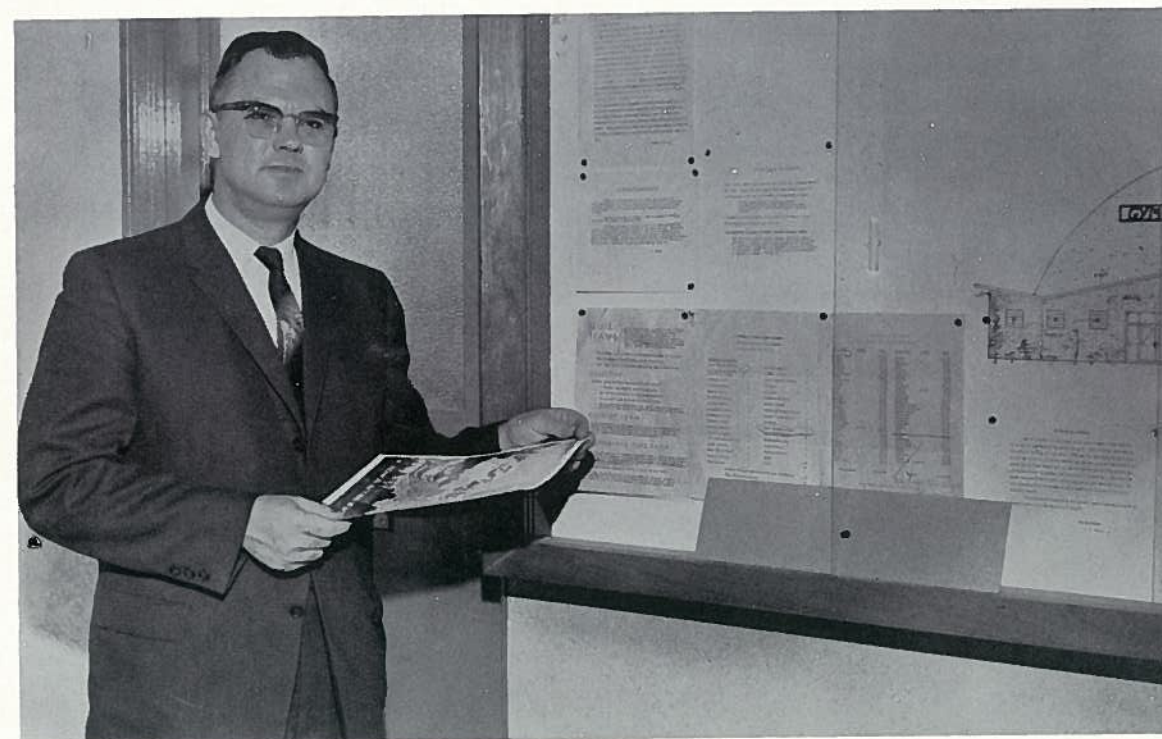
