



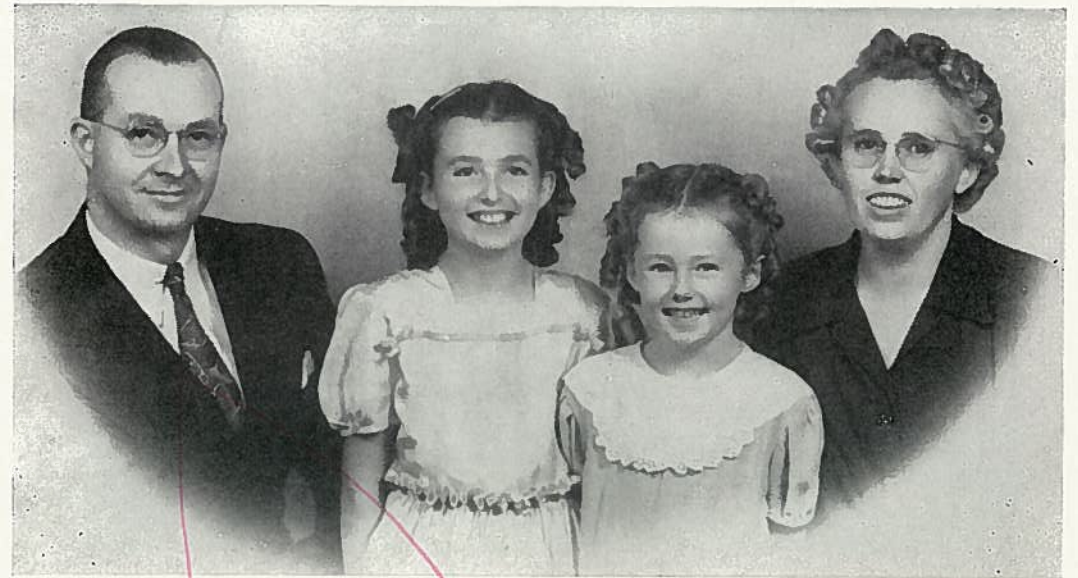




## *Foreword*
