The class of '45 is scattered far and wide in various occupations, but our aim is still for reunion in heaven.



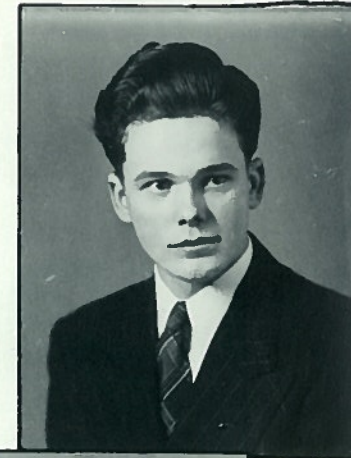
