## A Message From the Chairman of the Board



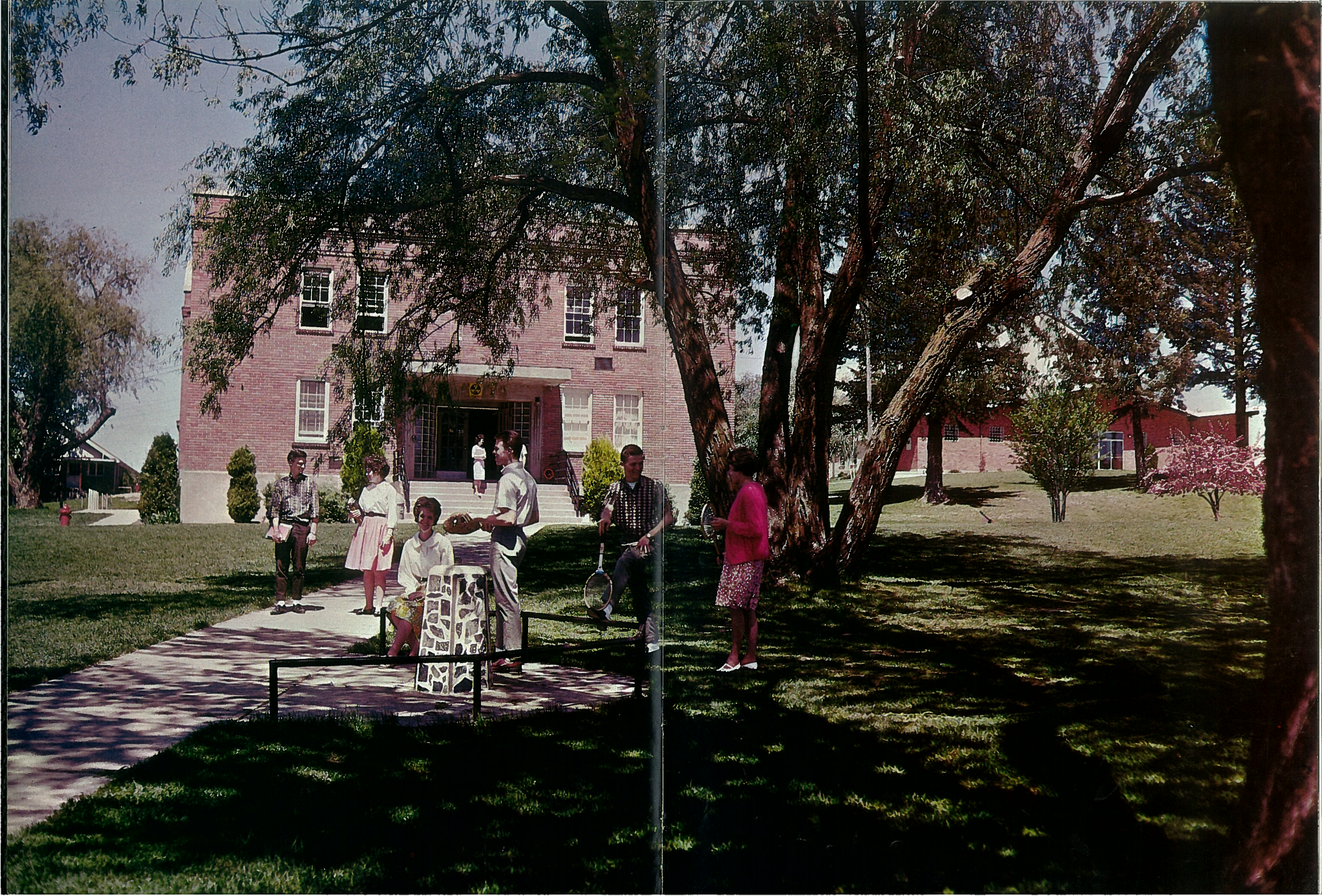

# A Message From the Editor

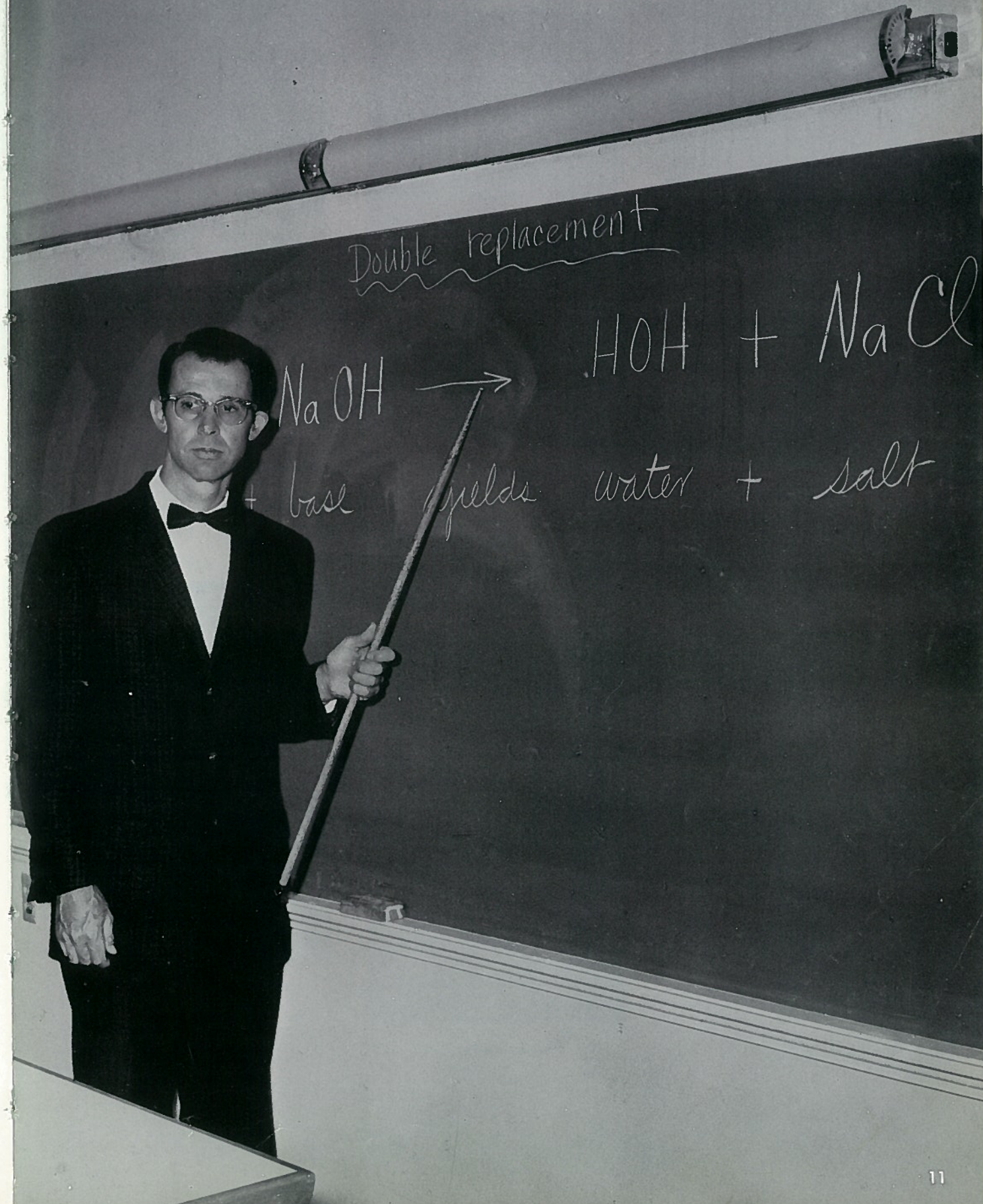

"Go ye therefor and teach all nations . . ."

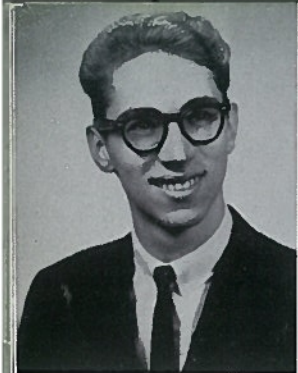

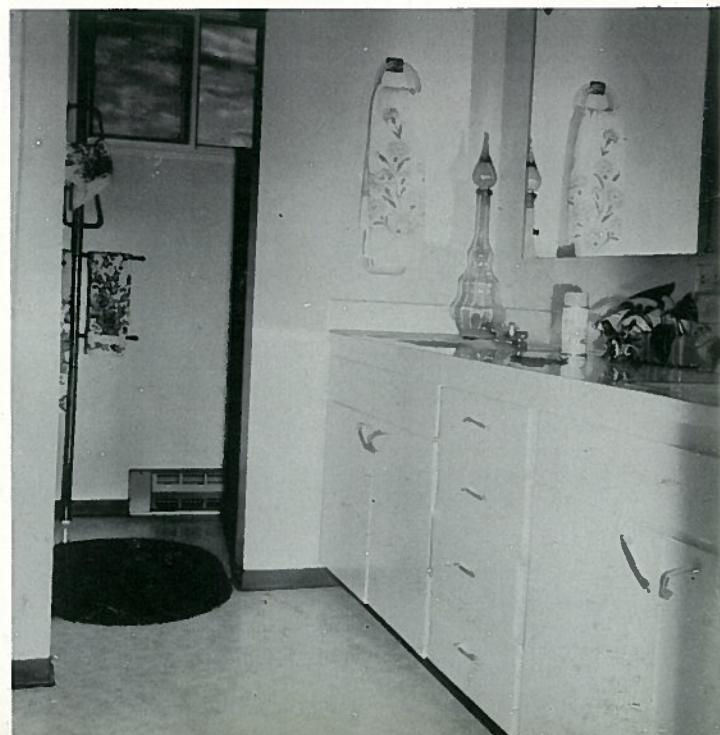
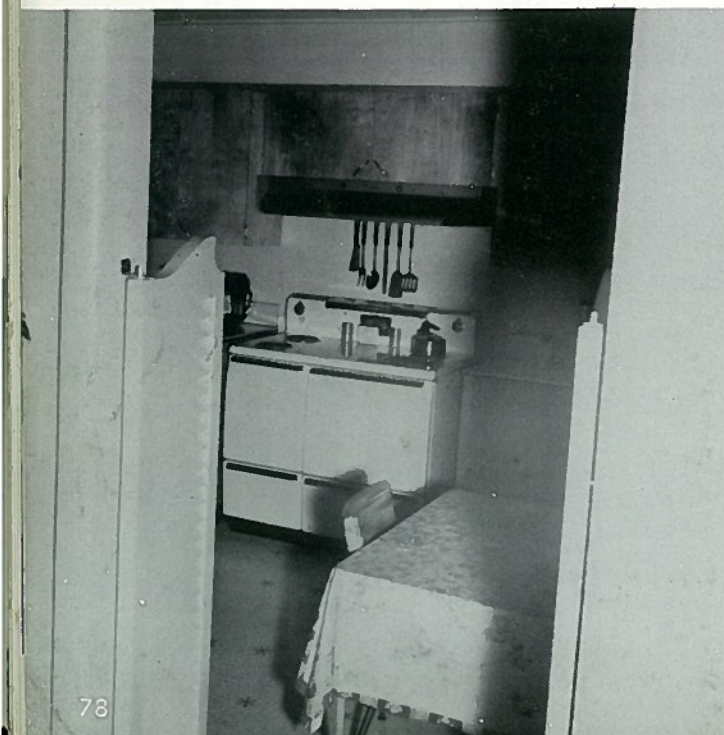


This house was constructed during the summer of 1963 by the Woodwork II class, under the direction of R. J. Freitas.
