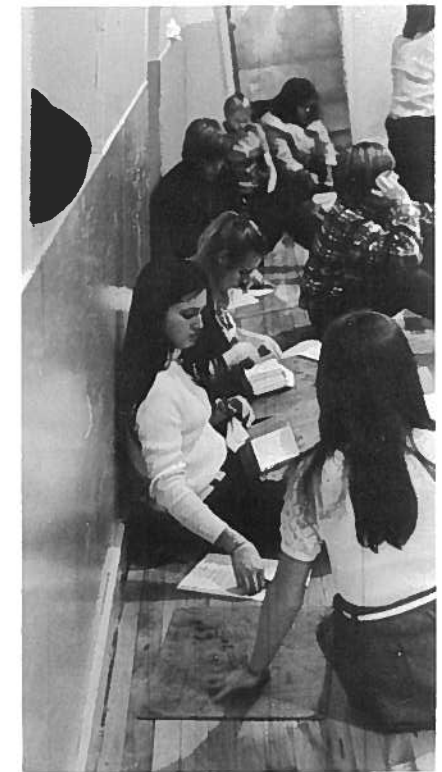


## ASB Means Fun and Accomplishment

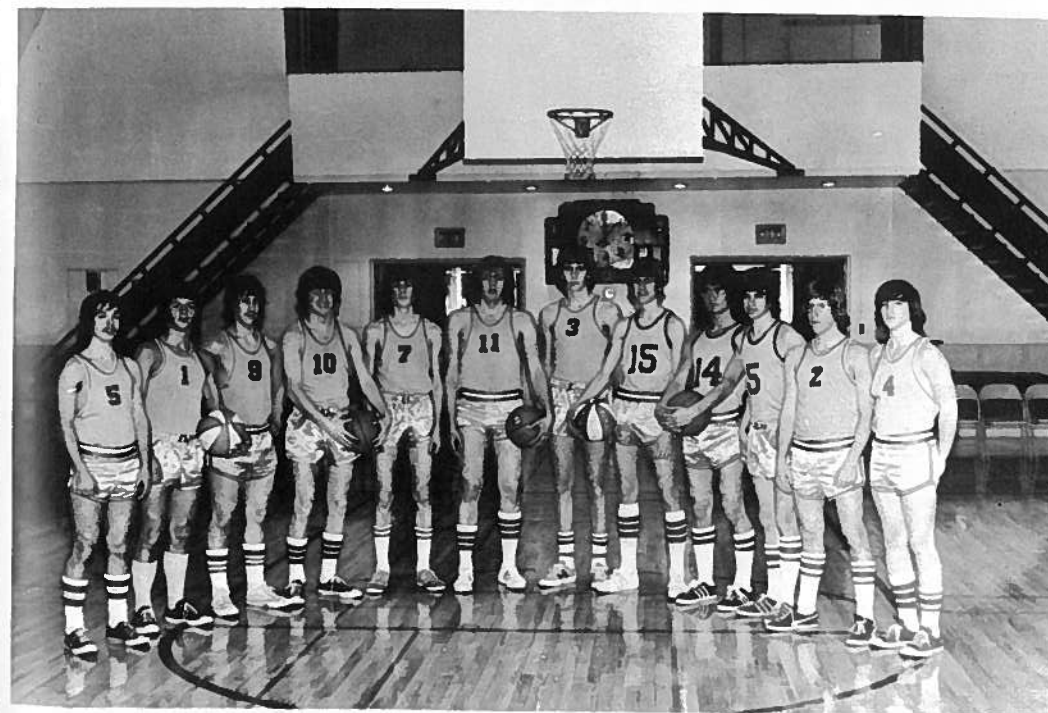
# Gymnastics and Basketball
