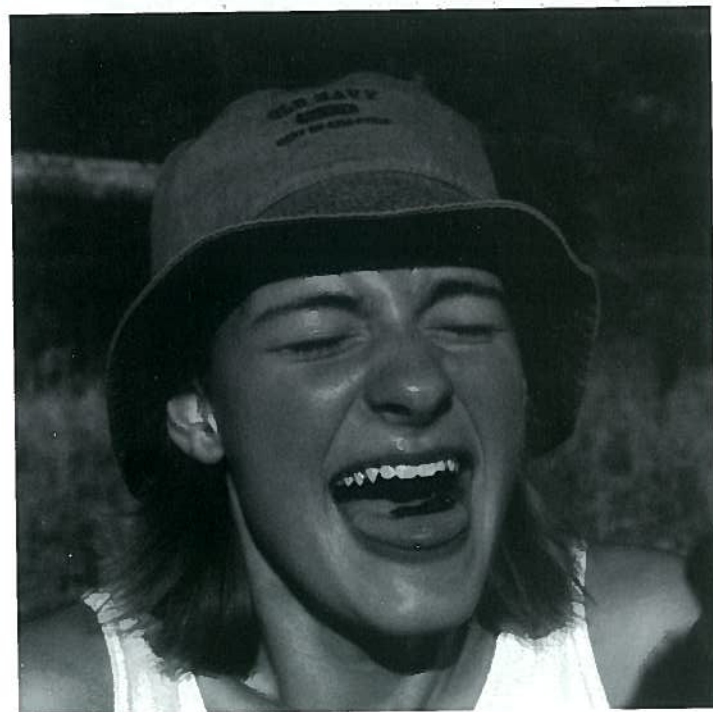


Senior Survival

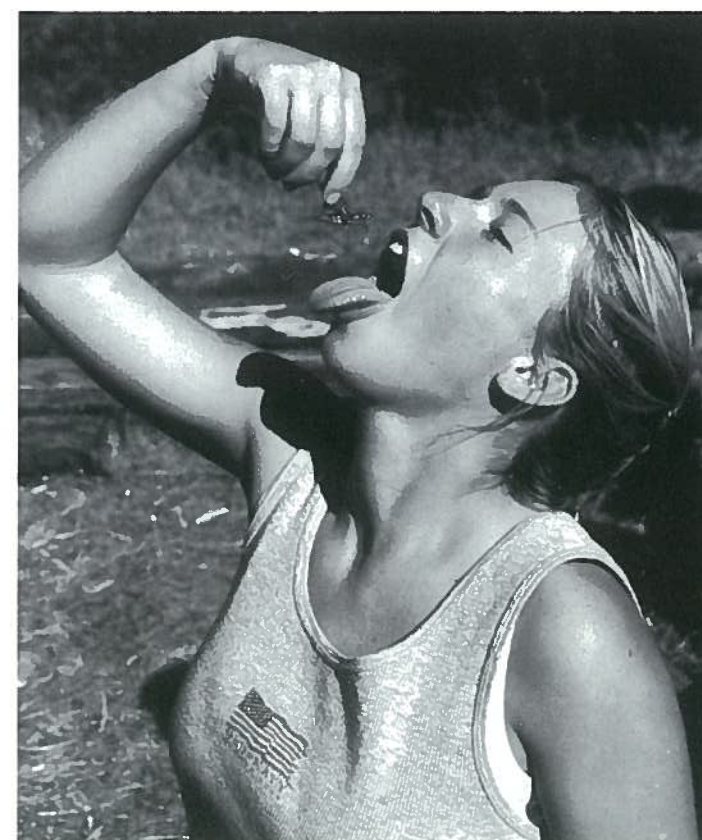
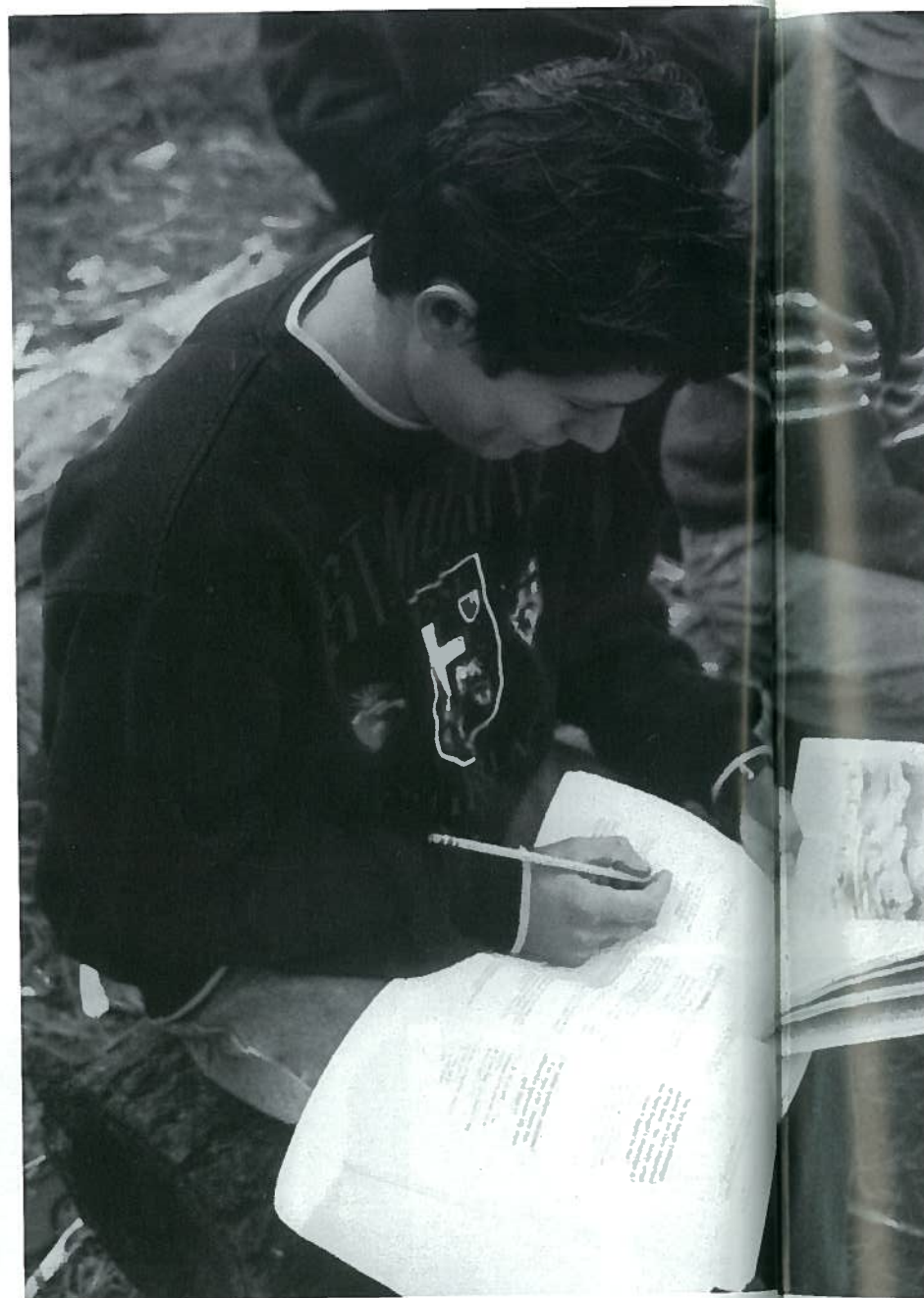
But, the question remains: How do you share it? That is a question that can't really be answered. All we can hope to do, is to live better because of it. And hope that our example is truly that, an example to others!

1948 The North Atlantic Treaty Organization is formed as a rival to the National Football League.

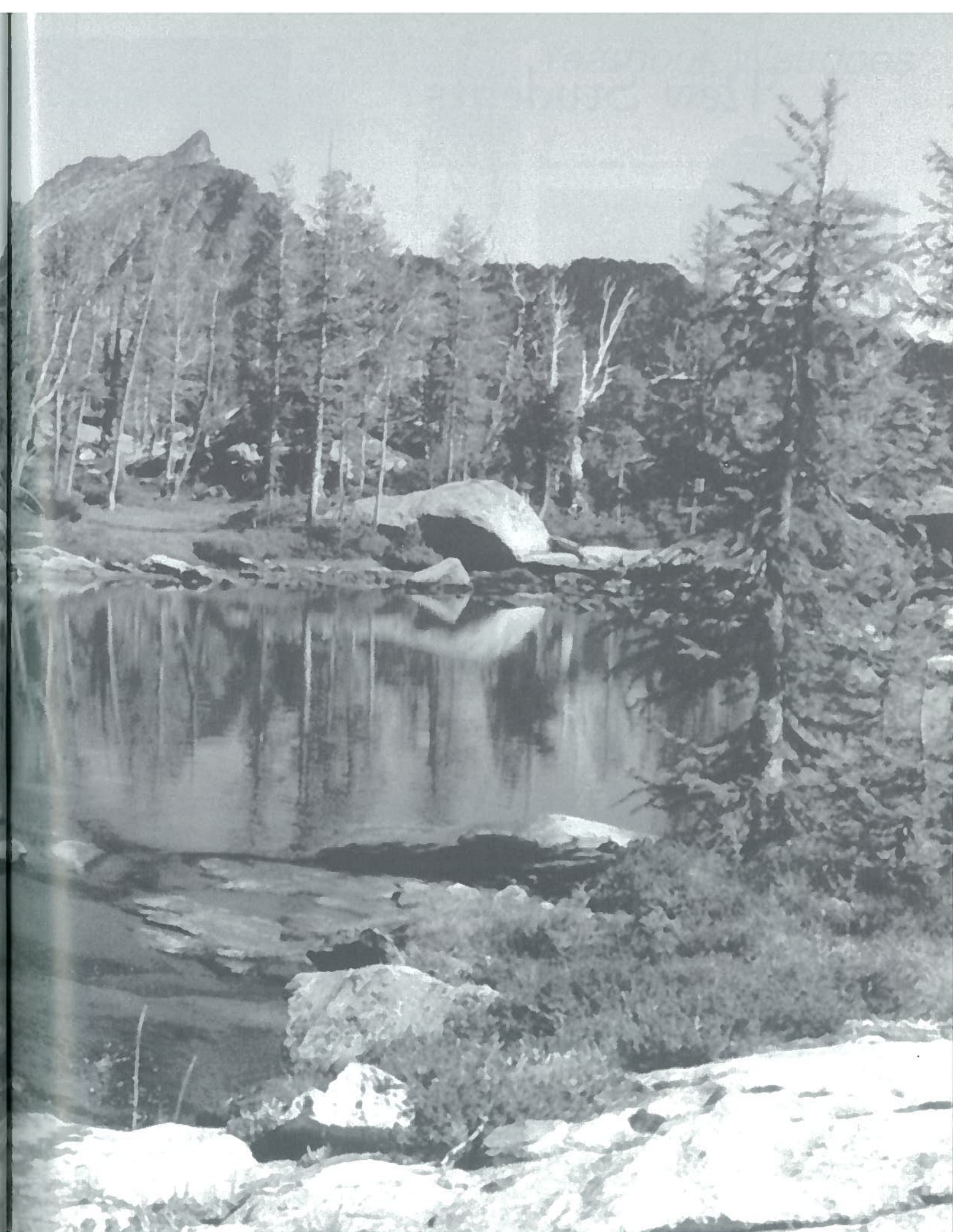
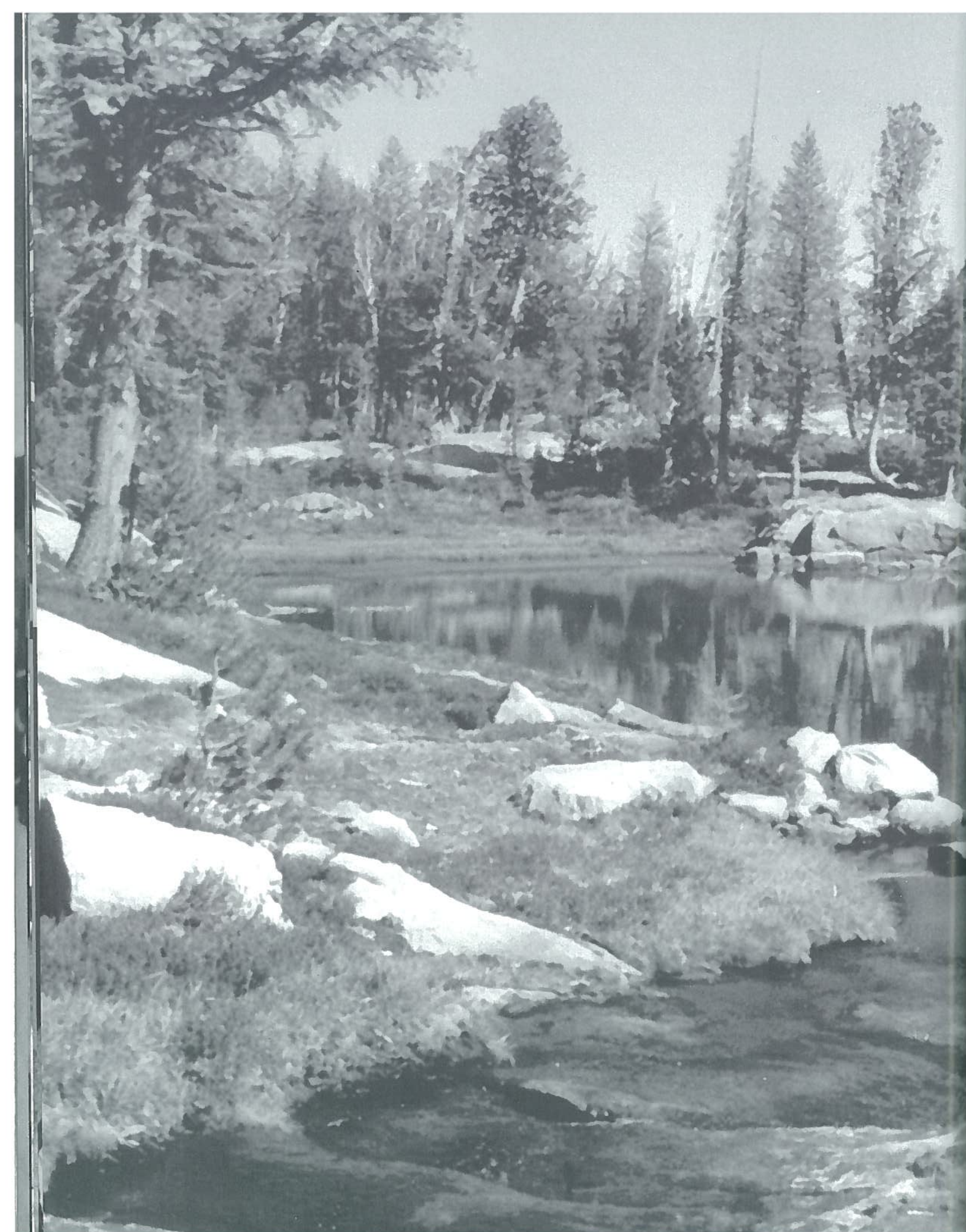
