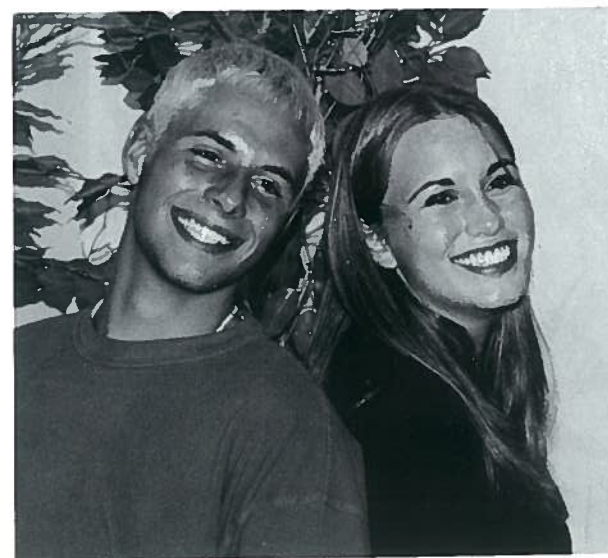

Fall Picnic

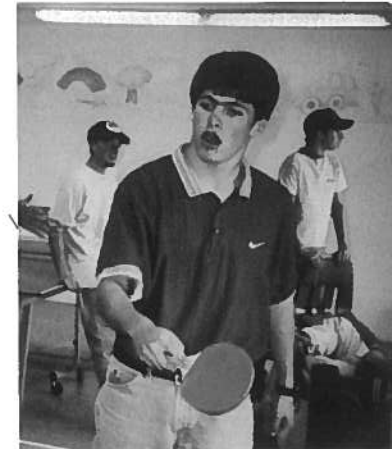

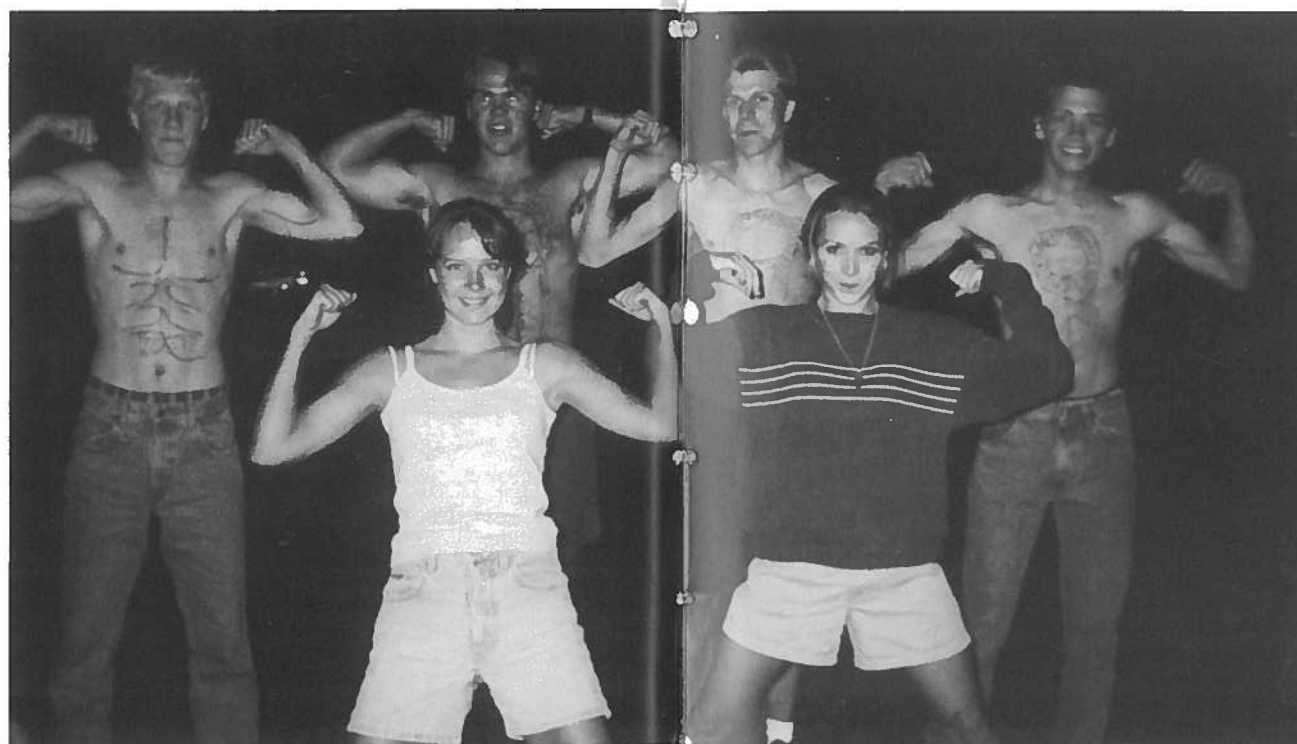

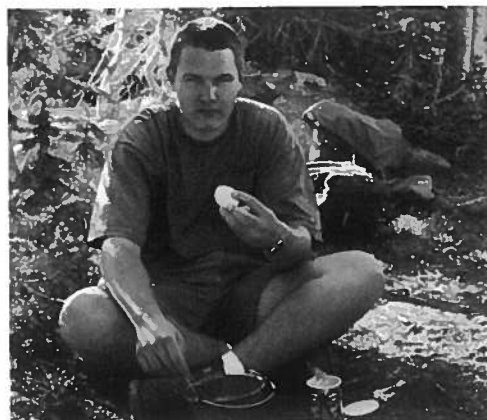
Outdoor Ed

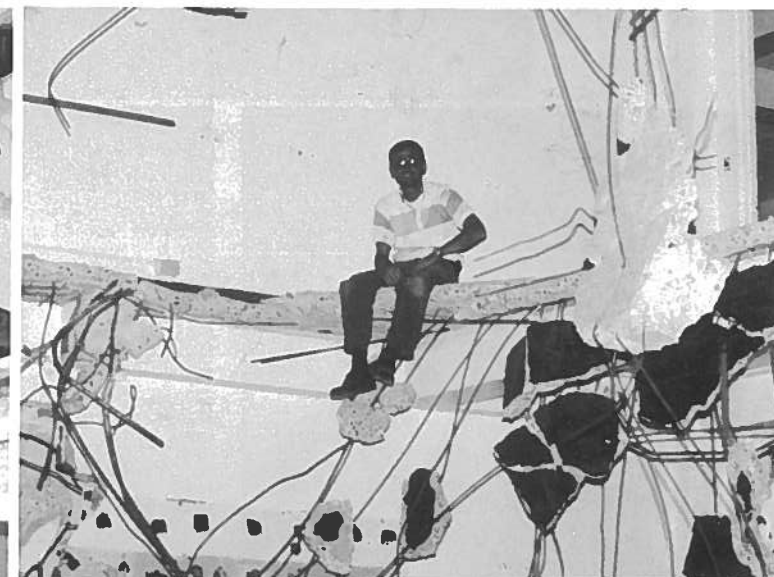
