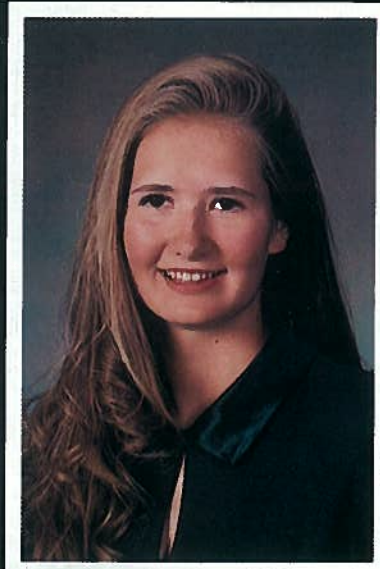
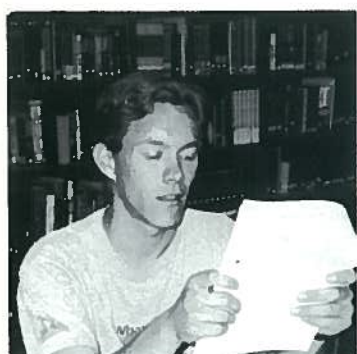


## 4- Year Seniors

We are the 4-year seniors of UCA, and this is what we have to say. We have lost our minds after such a long time, and are left so broke without even a dime. We have seen many students

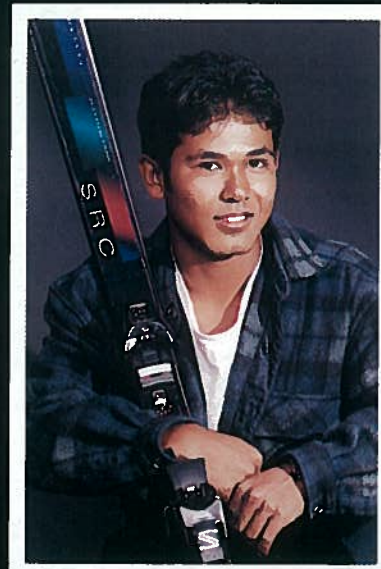
