
The Merry Men of the Forest

The Year's Events

<u>January</u> 1-The world welcomes the new century with spectacular celebrations, the best being in Paris with the Eiffel Tower exploding in a colorful pyrotechnic display. Vladimir Putin is appointed Russia's new president. 4- Florida State defeats Virginia Tech in the Sugar Bowl 46-29 to capture the NCAA National Championship. 30-In the most exciting Super Bowl of all time, the St. Louis Rams defeat the Tennessee Titans 23-16 with the Titans coming up one yard short of tying the game. Benjie Martling is born. After watching the birth, Daddy Martling watches the Super Bowl. He still isn't sure which he enjoyed more!

<u>February</u> 1-The American economy sets a new record for the longest period of growth in history – 107 months. 6-Hillary Rodham-Clinton becomes the first sitting First Lady to enter a political race as she announces her desire to run for a Senate seat from the State of New York.

March 12-Pope John Paul II visits the Holy Land and apologizes for the abuses of the Roman Catholic Church against Jews, women, other Christians and others.

April 3- A United States District Court rules that Microsoft violated anti-trust laws. Michigan State defeats Florida 89-76 to win the NCAA Men's Basketball National Championship.

22-Six year old Cuban Elian Gonzalez is forcibly seized in a pre-dawn raid by Federal Marshals after his Miami relatives had unsuccessfully attempted to keep him in the United States. Within hours is reunited with his father and on June 28th returns home to Havana.

May 4-A controlled management fire set by the Park Service in New Mexico is fanned by high winds into a wildfire, which eventually burns 50,000 acres and destroys 400 homes.

24-Israel pulls its military out of southern Lebanon after 22 years of occupation.

28-Juan Montoya wins the Indianapolis 500.

June 10-The New Jersey Devils defeat the Dallas Stars 4 games to 2 to win their second Stanley Cup Championship in six years.

13-15-For the first time since Korea was divided in 1945 leaders of both balves of the country meet for a series of meetings designed to lessen the tension between the North and South.

19-The Los Angeles Lakers defeat the Indiana Pacers 4 games to 2 to win the NBA Championship.

July 8- Fans jam bookstores as the latest "Harry Potter" book hits the shelves.

14- Punitive damages of \$144.8 billion is assessed against five leading tobacco companies.

25-Israeli-Palestinian Peace Summit fails, paving the way for renewed violence.

August 2-George W. Bush and Dick Cheney are nominated as the Republican Presidential and Vice Presidential candidates.

9-Bridgestone/Firestone recalls over 6.5 million tires. Eventually Ford Motor Company would also be involved in lawsuits stemming from hundreds of fatal accidents caused by tread separation on sports utility vehicles.

16-17-Al Gore and Joe Lieberman are nominated as the Democratic Presidential and Vice Presidential candidates. Lieberman is the first Jew so honored.

September 15-The 2000 Summer Olympics open in Sydney, Australia. The United States would eventually win 97 medals including 40 gold.


20-After six years and \$52 million the Independent Counsel ends the Clinton Whitewater investigation.

October 16-Missouri governor Mel Carnahan is killed in a plane crash while campaigning for a United States Senate seat. In a bizarre twist he is later elected posthumously. His widow fills his Senate seat.

26-New York is both winner and loser in the first "Subway Series" since 1956 as the Yankees win their 26th World Series Championship 4 games to 1 over the Mets.

November 7-In the most closely contested Presidential election in over a century, 100 millions votes were cast yet the final outcome hinged on only a few hundred disputed votes in Florida. In the next five weeks Democrats and Republicans battled in state and federal courts until the United States Supreme Court voted 5-4 in favor of the Republicans forcing Al Gore to concede on December 13th. Although Al Gore won more popular votes, George W. Bush won the Electoral College vote 271-266

<u>December</u> 24-Serbian President Slobodan Milosevic is ousted by pro-democracy demonstrators. Milosevic had been responsible for Serbia's defeat by NATO forces a year earlier.
