## The year's events

### March 2001 to February 2002

2001

March 5 – Charles Andrew Williams kills two students in a shooting rampage at a high school in Santee, California.

20 – The Dow Jones index drops 238.35 points as the American economy slides toward recession.

25 – “Gladiator” wins best picture at the Oscars.

April 1 – Tensions between China and the USA escalate following the forced landing of an American spy plane in China following a mid-air

collision with a Chinese fighter jet.

2 – Duke wins the NCAA College Basketball championship by defeating Arizona 82-72.

9 – Tiger Woods wins his 4<sup>th</sup> straight major golf title by winning the Masters Tournament.

May 5 – Monarchos wins the Kentucky Derby.

29 – Four men are found guilty in federal court of the two African embassy bombings in 1998 that killed 224.

June 9 – The Colorado Avalanche defeat the New Jersey Devils in game seven to win the Stanley Cup.

11 – Timothy McVeigh, the man who blew up the Oklahoma City Federal Building, is executed.

20 – Andrea Yates drowns her 5 children in a bath tub.

29 – Slobodan Milosevic, former leader of Yugoslavia, is delivered to The Hague, Netherlands for trial before an international court on charges of crimes against humanity.

July 2 – Robert Tools is given the first fully implanted artificial heart.

6 – Congressman Gary Condit is questioned about the disappearance of his intern and lover Sandra Levy.

20 – Anarchists riot in Genoa, Italy as the leaders of the seven great industrial powers meet.

August 9 – Palestinian suicide bomber kills 16 in a Jerusalem restaurant.

31 – The team from Bronx, New York is stripped of its victories in the Little League World Series because Danny Almonte is found to be 14 years old, too old to qualify for the tournament.

September 6 – The United States drops its move to break up Microsoft.

11 – In the greatest single attack on American soil four planes are hijacked by Al Qaida terrorists and used as guided missiles.

Two slam into and destroy the World Trade Center while one crashes into a wing of the Pentagon. The final plane is brought down in a Pennsylvania field when the hijackers are overpowered by passengers. All together over 4,000 people die. The event launches America's war on terrorism, but plunges the economy into a deep recession.

19 – American aircraft are ordered deployed to Uzbekistan and Tajikistan, former Soviet republics.

24 – Russia joins the war on terrorism.

October 7 – Barry Bonds delivers his 73<sup>rd</sup> home run. The American Air Force begins delivering bombs to Taliban and Al Qaida targets in Afghanistan.

Early October – Anthrax laced letters kill several people in the Northeast and shut down several key post offices.

12 – President Bush's approval rating reaches an unprecedented 89%.

Late October – American ground forces in concert with air power begins engaging and destroying enemy targets in Afghanistan.

November 3 – The four year old Arizona Diamondbacks come from behind in the ninth inning to defeat the New York Yankees in game seven of the World Series.

The entire month of November – American and Northern Alliance troops begin to disrupt and destroy the Taliban as a force in Afghanistan.

December – George Harrison of the Beatles dies of cancer. Enron declares bankruptcy. It is the largest bankruptcy in American history. Later investigation would reveal unethical auditing and monetary practices by top executives of the firm. Violence

between Palestinians and Israelis escalates. John Walker, an American fighting for the Taliban, is captured by American forces.

January – Thomas Junta, the infamous “hockey dad”, is convicted of beating to death Michael Costin another hockey dad at a youth hockey practice. Charles Bishop, a troubled fifteen year old, crashes his small plane into a Tampa skyscraper allegedly in support of Osama bin Laden.

February 3 – The New England Patriots pull off one of the greatest upsets in NFL history as they defeat the seemingly unbeatable St. Louis Rams 20-17 on a last play field goal.

8-24 – The Salt Lake City winter Olympics produce the usual thrills and spills as the United States garners a national record 34 medals, including 10 gold.

## SEPTEMBER 11, 2001

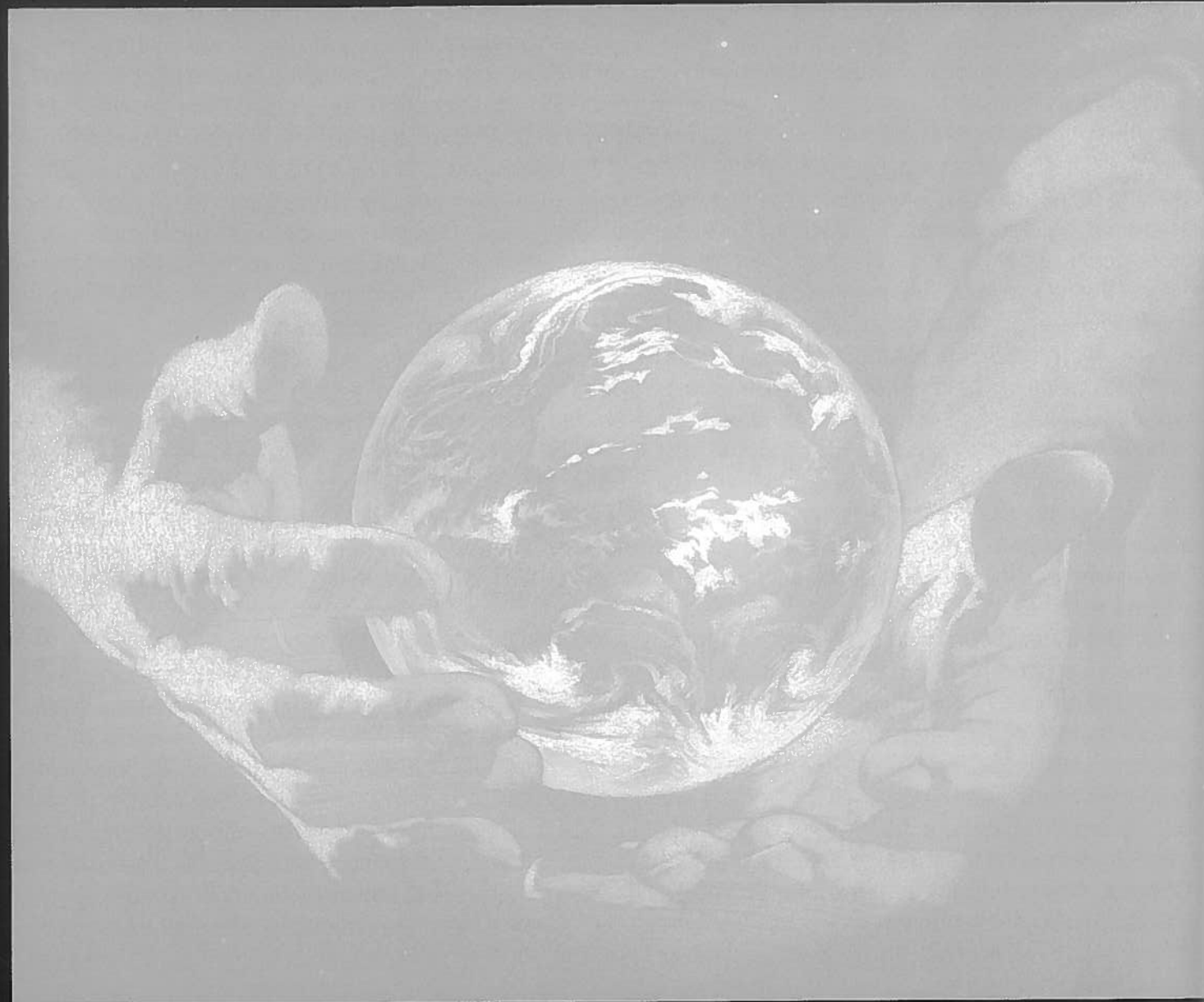
As a history teacher here at U.C.A. I regularly talk about major events in American and world history. But on the morning of September 11<sup>th</sup> I and the rest of my country were witnesses to the most horrific events in recent memory. When we went to bed on September 10<sup>th</sup> life seemed normal and routine. It was the same for the victims of the following morning. Sometime in the wee hours of the eleventh, while we on the west coast continued to sleep, thousands of men and women in New York and Washington awoke to begin another ordinary day, a day that dawned clear and warm and beautiful. At about 6:15 am Pacific Time, as I lay half asleep, the phone rang. It was my sister Dawn in Pennsylvania. Her words jolted me into consciousness instantly – “They’re attacking the World Trade Center!” As I stumbled to the living room my mind groped for some kind of meaning to her words. Then the image appeared – two horribly scarred towers, with which I was very familiar, belching the blackest smoke I’d ever seen. As the commentator fumbled for words, I sat dumbstruck by what I was witnessing. New York City is not some far off place on a map, it is my home town. I had seen the towers rise, and now I was witnessing their death throes. Over and over I watched the replays of the second plane puncturing the South Tower and blossoming into an white and orange fireball. As a numb observer I witnessed my city stop and recoil from the blows. Then suddenly the South Tower vanished from the skyline in a billowing blanket of soot and debris. Shortly, the North Tower began its slow pancaking collapse. One lone spire of concrete and steel quivered defiantly for a moment above the smoke before vanishing into the tomb of over 3,500 innocent people. I felt a tear running down my cheek. To the south the Pentagon was attacked, and in Pennsylvania Todd Beamer and some ordinary heroes, not unlike you and I, foiled another attack. Fighter planes streaked across the skies of America as Air Force One landed at an undisclosed location. The ghosts of Pearl Harbor were heard whispering. Then followed the silence of the 12<sup>th</sup> as air traffic completely halted over the United States, and a nation began to grieve and find the resolve to rise from the ashes.

In the days to come we did rise as a nation. We learned that heroism didn’t end with World War II; that young men and women of today are every bit as brave and heroic as any our nation has ever produced. We realized that courage and faith and duty and dedication and unselfishness and patriotism still matter. We found out that we were not African-Americans or Asian-Americans or Irish-Americans. We were all just Americans; one united family. We learned that ordinary people could do extraordinary things. Suddenly, we respected firefighters and police officers again. We shook hands with men and women in uniform, and actually talked to strangers. We hugged our kids, our parents, our brothers and sister, our friends. And we prayed. We threw off the malaise and tinsel of the previous decade and rediscovered the heartbeat and soul of America. Now when we hear the Star Spangled Banner we know what the song and its nation are all about. Never forget that lesson. For someday, when your grandchildren are struggling with their American History assignment and ask you about September 11, 2001, you’ll get a far-away look in your wise old eyes and say, “Yes, I remember...”
