# music

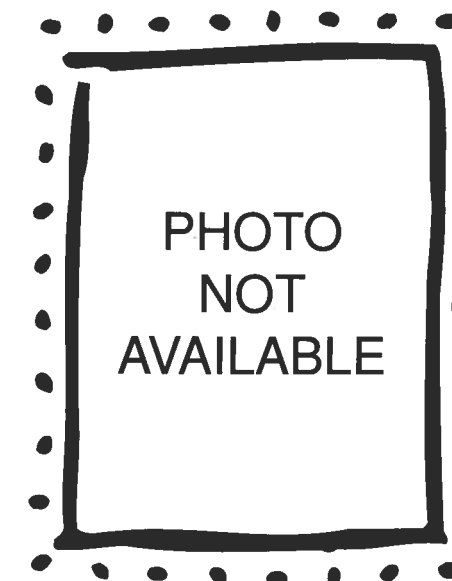
