"It is like a person who builds a house on a strong foundation laid upon the underlying rock. When the floodwaters rise and break against the house, it stands firm because it is well built."

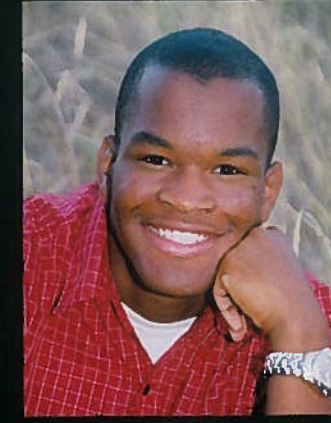
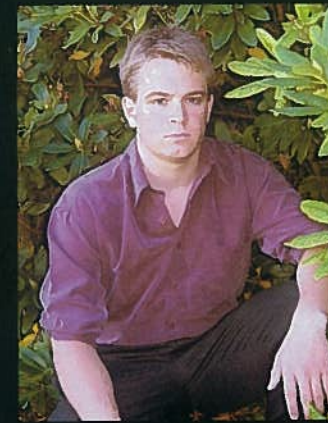

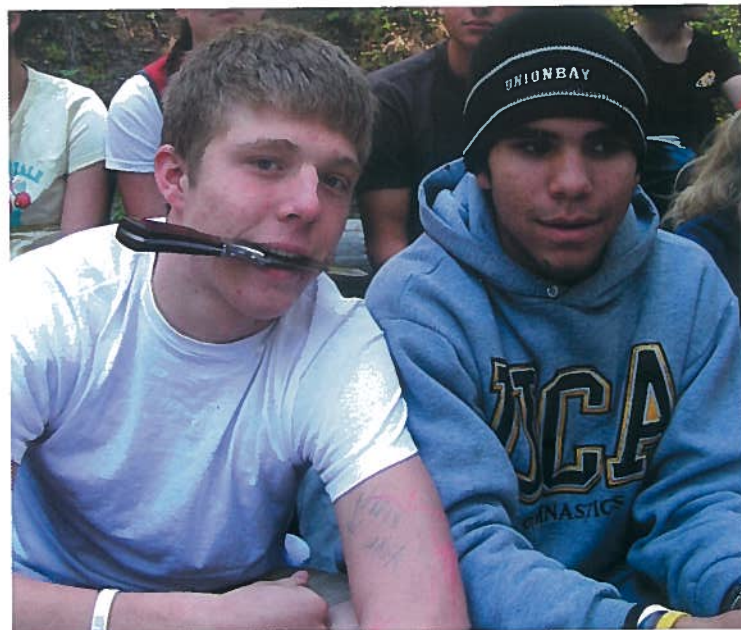
SENIOR SURVIVAL

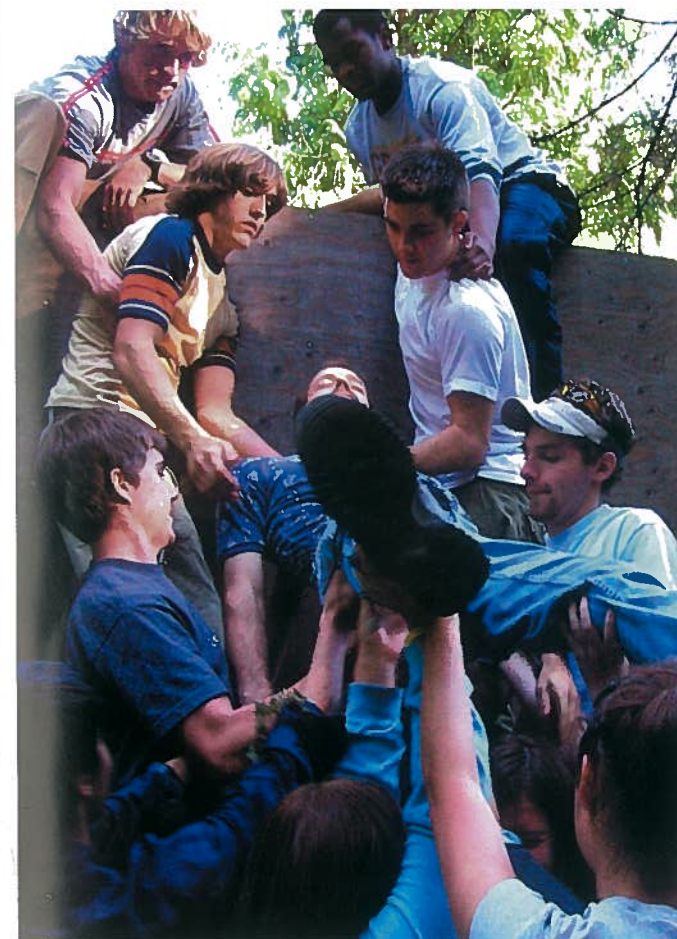

2001 THROUGH 2005

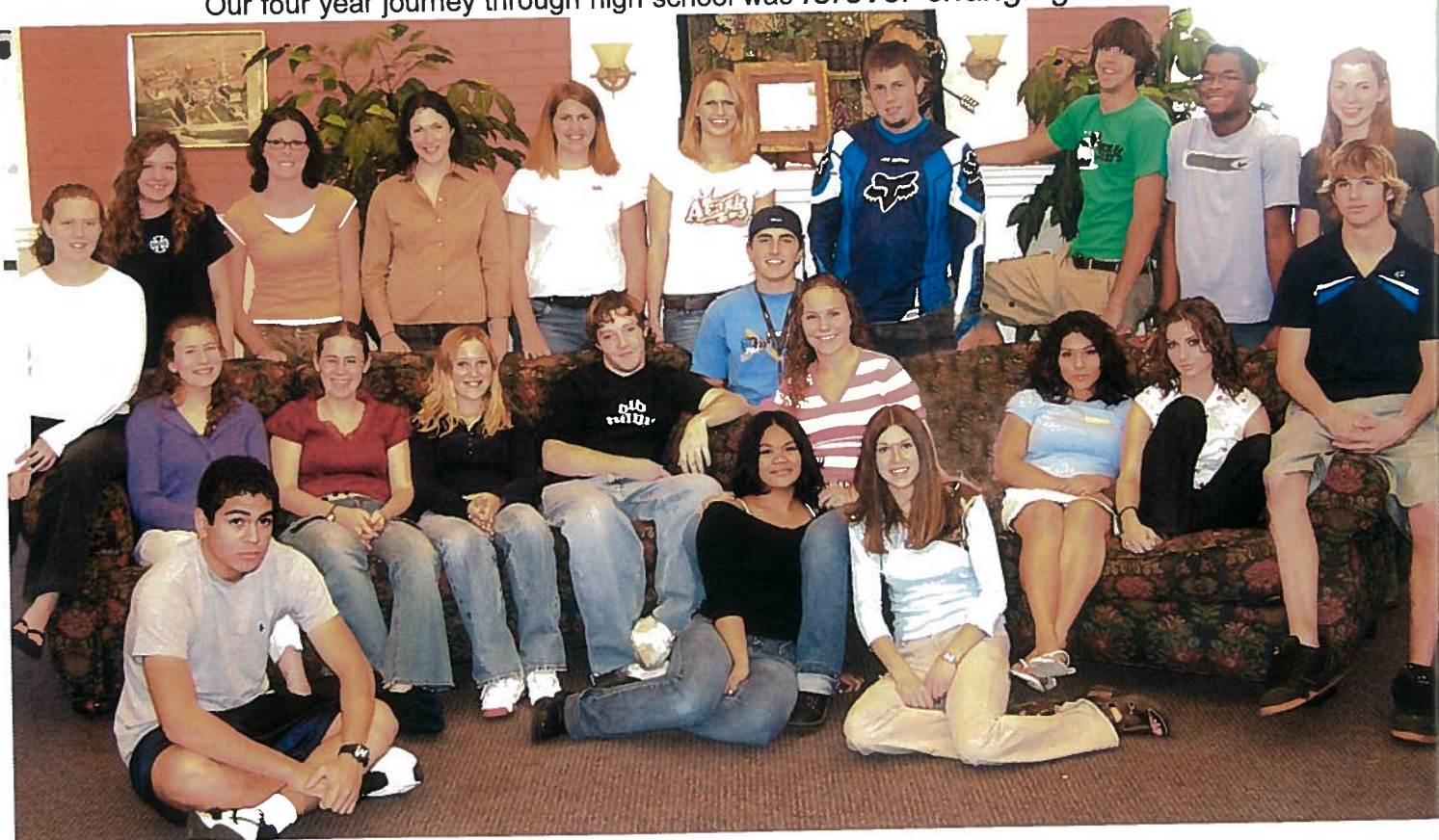

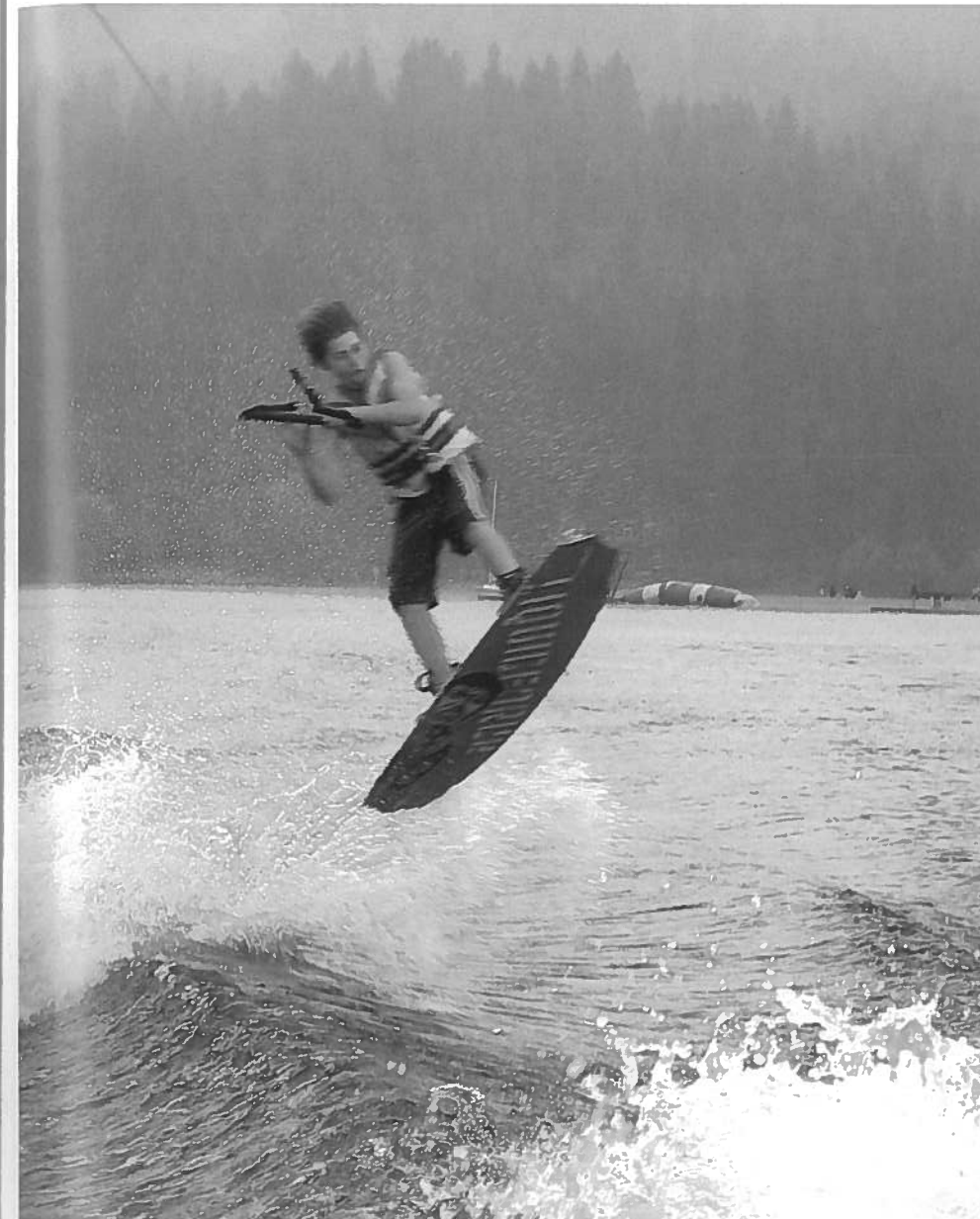

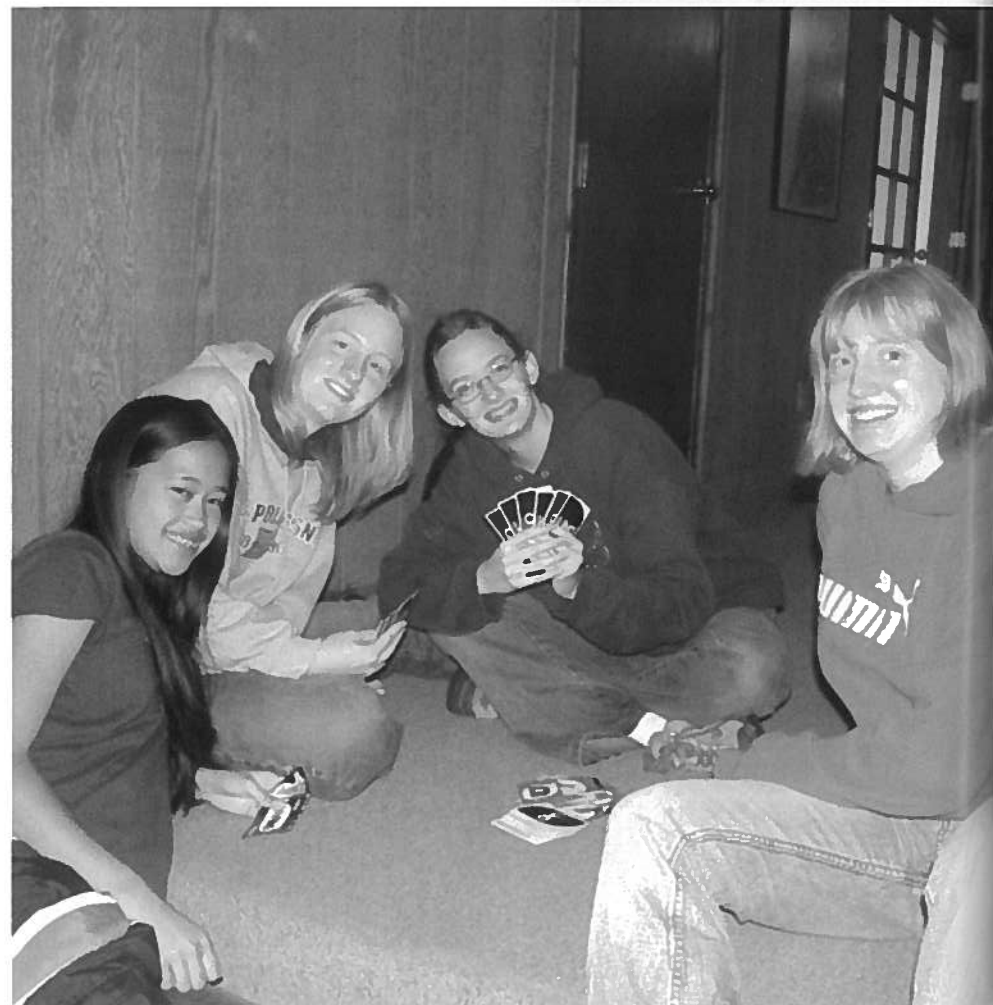

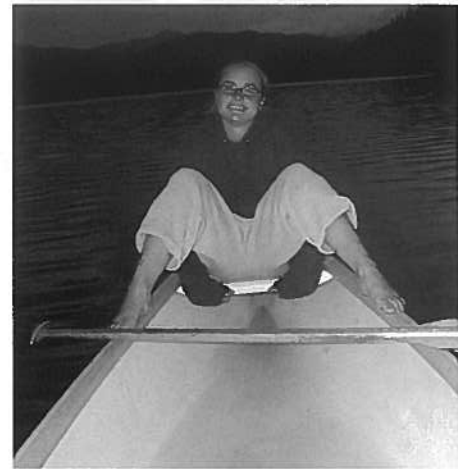
