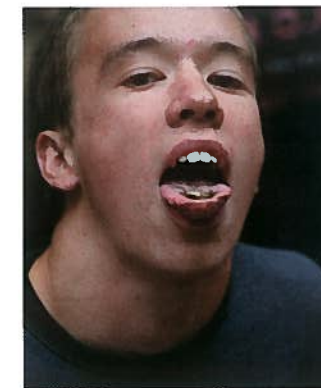

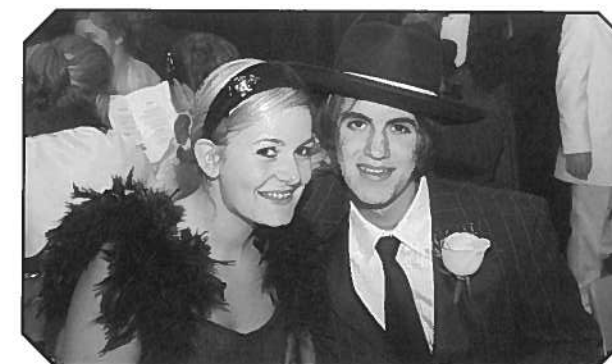
Winter Banquet

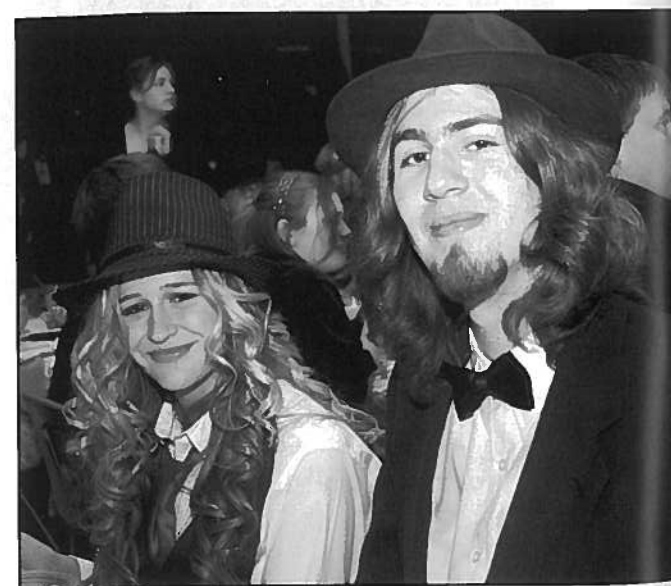

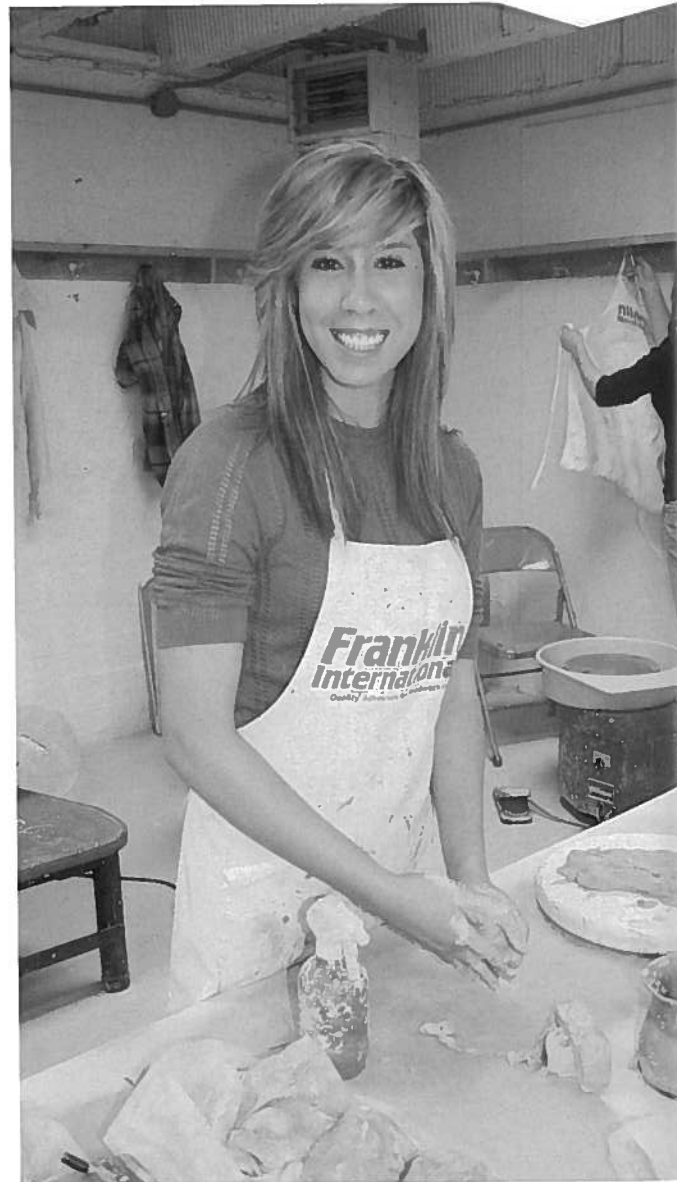

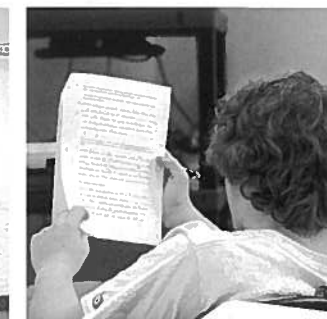
