Launch Into...

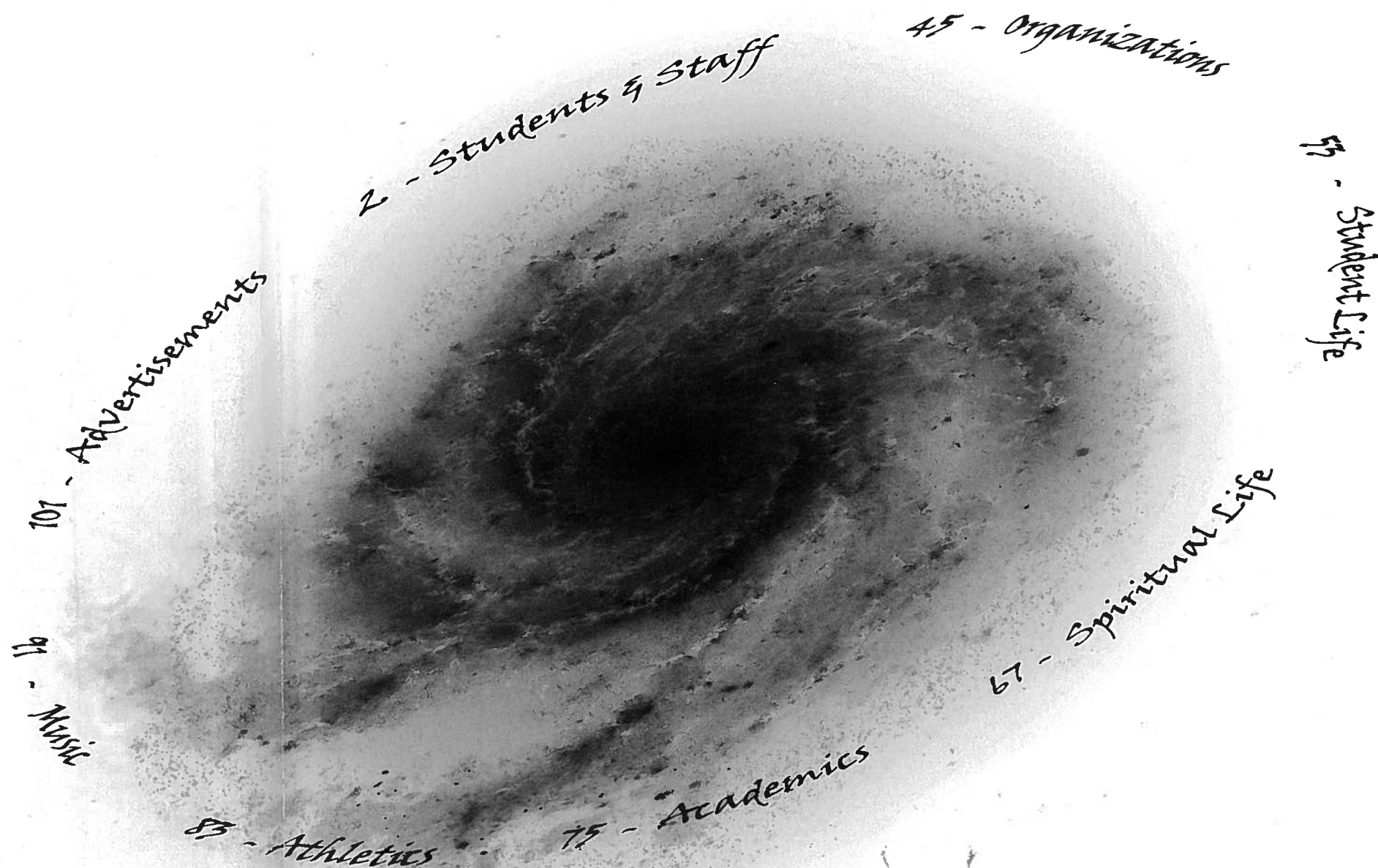
"Fly...are you ready?"
